The home has 31 bedrooms mostly single rooms, many with en-suite facilities, with a small selection of twin rooms for those individuals who prefer to share. There is a reception area welcoming you in to the home ,and any of the staff we welcome you into the home and offer what you require. There is a large activity lounge situated on the ground floor which also leads to our easily accessible garden which was designed with and by our residents.

At the front of the building we have a reception lounge, and this is also used for the pampering sessions for the residents and interactive activities with the magic table.





ACTIVITIES

The home offers a wide and varied range of activities designed to encourage our residents to retain mobility and more importantly keep an interest in daily living. The home has dedicated activity organisers who tailor the activities to the resident's abilities, strengths, hobbies and interests. They also follow seasonal events celebrations and topical events. Residents are encouraged to make wishes and the staff make it their mission to make wishes come true. The home also has a mini-van to support our residents to take part in activities out in the community. The home provides entertainment and social gatherings with shows, singers and animal therapy.

FOOD

We have a dedicated Cook at Ashtongrange and prepares an extensive nutritiously balanced menu based on the resident's choices, preferences and dietary requirements. We encourage our residents to have their meals at one of our communal dining areas but individual choice is respected and room service is provided if preferred. Meal times are important and people are offered assistance with their meals if they require it.

From London Take the M23 and exit at junction 11, take the A264 towards Horsham then take 1st exit at roundabout onto Rusper Rd, then 3rd exit onto Giblets Way then 1st exit at final roundabout onto N Heath Lane and turn left onto Richmond Road.
